

**O.S.No. 245/2026**

Perused the plaint averments, I.A.No.2 along with affidavit and documents produced by the plaintiffs. On perusal of check-slip, it is found that there is no caveat in this case.

At this stage, I am of the opinion that if Ex-parte temporary injunction is not granted against the defendant No.6, the purpose of the suit will not be served and it may lead to multiplicity of proceedings. The plaintiffs have made out prima facie case to grant T.I. at this stage.

Hence, Ex-parte temporary injunction order is granted against the defendant No.6 restraining him from alienating the suit schedule property. The Order will be in force till next date of hearing or till appearance of defendants whichever is earlier.

Plaintiffs shall comply Order 39 Rule 3.

Issue notice on T.I, I.A.1 & 2 and suit summons to the defendants.
