The plaintiff No.1 is present.

Heard on I.A.No.1 and perused the documents.

The plaintiffs have filed the suit for Partition & Separate Possession and the records show that, the Item No.3 was alienated in the year 2015 in favor of the defendants No.7 to 12.

Therefore, except the Item No.3, the I.A.No.1 in respect of remaining properties is allowed and the defendants No.1 to 6 are restrained from creating third party rights in respect of Items No.1, 2, 4 to 7 by way of Exparte Temporary Injunction Order. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

I.A.No.1 is allowed in part.

The defendant No.1 to 6 are restrained from creating third party rights over the Items No.1, 2, 4 to 7 of the plaint schedule properties by way of Exparte Temporary Injunction Order till appearance of all the defendants.

The plaintiffs shall comply the Order 39 Rule 3 of C.P.C. provisions.

Office to issue certified copy of this Order only after plaintiffs show compliance report by sending plaint, I.A. copies and documents copies by R.P.A.D to the defendants No.1 to 6 and by ordinary mode to defendants No.7 to 11.

They shall issue summons to both the defendants by furnishing plaint, I.A. copies and all the documents.

If the plaintiffs did not comply the above Order in letter and spirit, the temporary injunction Order shall not be continued.

Issue suit summons and I.A. notice to defendants and along with injunction Order by R.P.A.D to the defendants No.1 to 6 and by ordinary mode to defendants No.7 to 11.
