- 4) Whether the defendant No.3 proves that, the properties shown in the written statement of the defendants No.1 & 2 are the self acquired properties of her husband?
- 5) Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the relief of Partition and Separate Possession as sought for?
- 6) Whether the defendants No.1 & 2 are entitled for the relief sought in the counter claim?
- 7) Whether the defendant No.3 is entitled for the relief sought in the counter claim?
- 8) What Order or Decree?
