- 1) Whether the plaintiffs prove that themselves and defendant are the members of Hindu undivided joint family and the suit schedule property is their joint family property?
- 2) Whether the plaintiffs prove that they are entitled for partition and separate possession of ½ shares in the suit schedule property?
- 3) Whether the plaintiff proves that the defendant is trying to interfering with their peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit property?
- 4) Whether the defendant proves that originally land bearing Sy. No. 68 belongs to K.S. Anjinappa and he sold the same to defendants father through registered sale deed dated 03-02-1965, after his death this defendant succeeded the said property?
- 5) Whether the defendant proves that the land bearing Sy. No. 71/ measuring 4 acres 15 guntas was originally owned by his father and the husband of 1st plaintiff, after their death he is in possession and enjoyment and also managing the property as co-owner?

- 6) Whether the defendant proves that he is the absolute owner to an extent of 2 acres 7 ½ guntas in Sy. No. 71?
- 7) Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the relief as sought for?
- 8) Whether order or decree?
