Bhaskar More Vs. Changdeo More and others

ORDER BELOW EXH.1

The plaintiff in RCS No.315/2016 (Bhaskar Vs. Changdeo More+7) and the defendant No.1 in RCA No.600/2014 (Changdeo Vs. Bhaskar+3), has prayed for transfer of both suits to one Court.

2. Heard Adv. Rajapurkar for applicant. Perused the record.

3. Though the application is proceeded either ex-parte, or without say of the non-applicants, it is apparent from the plaint of both suits that the properties involved in both suits are not same. All the parties in RCS No. 600 of 2014 are not arrayed as a party to the present application. Therefore, both cases cannot be ordered to be transferred to the one Court, without giving an opportunity to all the defendants in RCS No.600 of 2014, who are not arrayed as a party to the present application. So also, the applicant was unable to satisfy as to what reason, prejudice will be caused to him, if both cases are tried by the different Courts. Hence, the following order.
