- 05.** Whether the plaintiff further proves that defendants have created Registered Sale Deed dated 09-09-2004/10-09-2004 relating to suit item No.29 illegally?
- 06.** Whether the defendants No.14 & 15 prove that they are the bonafide purchaser of suit item No.29 for valuation consideration through Registered Sale Deed on 09-09-2004/10-09-2004?
- 07.** Whether the plaintiff is entitle for the reliefs as sought for?
- 08.** What Order or Decree?
