1. Arguments heard on bail application of applicant-accused.
2. Learned Counsel for applicant-accused submitted that the applicant-accused has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is submitted that no specific role is attributed to applicant/accused. No prima facie case is made out against applicant/accused. Nothing is to be got recovered from applicant/accused. Applicant/accused is ready and willing to join the investigation, however, since the offence under which the present FIR has been registered involves non-bailable offences, therefore, applicant/accused is apprehending his arrest. Applicant/accused undertakes to abide by all the terms and conditions as may be imposed by

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the court while directing to release him on bail. Hence, the prayer to admit the applicant to anticipatory bail.

3. Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor prayed for dismissal of application in view of nature and gravity of offence.

4. As per version of FIR, present case was registered on the statement of Inderjit Singh son of Naib Singh resident of Adamke, in which, he stated that a few days ago, Rajwinder Singh had filed an application against him in the police station Sardulgarh regarding the dispute their joint motor and partition of land. Discussions were also going on in the village panchayat. On 05-05-2026, the panchayat gave 4 days time to both the parties, so, on that day, they came to the police station and took 4 days time. It was about 4:30/5:00 when he reached the street of Fatte Wale Doctor, near the private school, then he saw a car in front and a car behind him coming towards him. He turned into the street, then both the vehicles turned behind him. One car stopped in front of him and one car stopped behind him. The vehicle in front of him was bearing registration No.PB-31-1525 and the vehicle behind him was bearing registration No.HR-42-8921. Many persons alighted from the cars who were armed with rods, baseball bats, sticks, etc. In i20 car bearing registration No.PB-31-1525, from the driver's seat, Amandeep Singh alias Jaffa, who was armed iron rod surrounded him and raised lalkara and gave blow of iron rod which hit on his left arm. In the meantime,

Virdavinder Singh alias Happy (present applicant/accused), who was coming from the driver's seat of the other vehicle, threatened him with baseball bat. Amandeep Singh alias Jaffe took away the gold chain, which was weighing 1 ½ tolas, from him and took it into his possession. About 5/6 people came out from the vehicles. In front of them, Rajwinder Singh was coming. He was armed with stick and gave blow of stick which hit on his left leg. When he tried to run away, they all surrounded him and started beating him. He raised alarm. All the the accused fled away from the spot.

5. Complainant Inderjit Singh has come present in the Court and suffered statement that compromise has been effected between him and accused Amandeep Singh @ Aman Jaffa and Virdavinder Singh alias Happy. He has tendered compromise deed in other bail application which is pending for today. He has no objection if the bail application of applicant/accused is allowed.

6. The present case is registered u/s 126(2), 308(2), 115(2), 190, 191(3), 351(2) of BNS. As per version of complainant, applicant/accused threatened him with baseball bat. As per opinion of the doctor, there are 8 injuries on the person of complainant and all the injuries are simple in nature. Further as per statement of complainant, compromise has been effected. Applicant-accused is ready to join the investigation and to cooperate with the investigating agency.

7. In view of the above facts and circumstances, when applicant-accused is ready to join the investigation, without expression of opinion on merits of the case, he is admitted to interim anticipatory bail and is directed to join the investigation on or before 01.06.2026. In case applicant-accused join investigation, he shall be admitted on interim anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer/SHO/Arresting Officer subject to the following conditions:-

1. That applicant-accused shall make himself available for investigation by the police officer as and when required.
2. That applicant-accused directly or indirectly shall not make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or any Police Officer.
3. That applicant-accused shall not leave the country without prior permission of the court.
4. That applicant shall appear on each and every date of hearing of the court.

After joining the investigation, report be submitted on 03.06.2026 and police report be also produced on the said date. Police record be returned. Copy of bail order be sent to the SHO/Incharge of Police Station concerned through Naib Court.
