- 5) Whether the defendant Nos.1 to 3 proves that, the part of suit item No.8 property to an extent of 15 guntas and part of suit item No.2 property to an extent of 20 guntas were granted to Hanumantharayappa (father in law of defendant No.1) and said properties are no way concerned to plaintiff?
- 6) What order or decree?
