**ISSUES**

- 1) Whether the plaintiffs prove that, plaintiffs and the defendants No.1 to 11 are members of the Hindu Joint Family and they are having 1/6<sup>th</sup> share in the suit schedule property as the same is their joint family property?
- 2) Whether the plaintiffs further prove that, the defendant No.12 has obtained the Registered G.P.A. from the defendants No.1 & 6 on the Guise of managing the property and he has executed Registered Sale Deed dated 01.06.2005 in favor of the defendant No.13 without disclosing the same to the plaintiffs and other defendants?
- 3) Whether the suit for Partition & Declaration filed after expiry of more than 11 years from the date of alienation is maintainable and the Court Fee paid is proper?
- 4) Whether the defendants No.13 & 14 prove that, the defendants No.2 to 4 have filed O.S.No.120/2014 against the defendant No.13 & others and the said suit was dismissed as compromised and therefore, the present suit is not maintainable?
- 5) Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the relieves claimed?
