

State Vs. Jashandeep Singh @ Deepu BA-100-25

Police record received and perused.

This order of mine shall dispose of bail application filed by the applicant/accused Jashandeep Singh @ Deepu in case FIR No.77 dated 27.10.2024, under Sections 331(4), 305 BNS, PS Cheema.

The counsel for applicant/accused averred that false case has been registered against the accused. Accused is innocent and has never committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. The presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take long time and no fruitful purpose will be served by keeping the accused behind the bars. Hence, a prayer to release the accused on bail has been made.

On the other hand, APP for the State has averred that as the offence involved in this case is of serious nature and presence of accused is required for further progress in the case, so accused should not be released on bail.

Heard. Perusal of the police record as well as remand papers shows that accused Jashandeep Singh @ Deepu is also involved in FIR No. 78 dated 27.10.2024, under Sections 457, 380 IPC, PS Cheema, FIR No. 79 dated 27.10.2024, under Sections 457, 380 IPC, PS Cheema and FIR No. 80 dated 27.10.2024, under Sections 457, 380 IPC, PS Cheema. Further the allegations against the accused are of serious and grave in nature and as per police record, he seems to be habitual offender. So, considering the seriousness and gravity of the allegations leveled against the accused/applicant and the sentence provided

under Sections 331(4), 305 BNS, accused/applicant Jashandeep Singh @ Deepu is not entitled to get concession of bail at this stage. Hence, bail application of accused-applicant is declined. Police record be returned and papers be attached with the remand papers.
