Heard on bail application filed on behalf of accused/ applicant Ashok Kumar. Learned Counsel for the applicant/ accused has argued that accused has been falsely implicated in the present case and since then the accused is in custody. He further argued that the present case was registered on the statement of ASI Harjit Singh. No complaint was given by any person against the accused and no payment was received by the applicant from any person. He further argued that presentation of challan will take long time and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused in custody. He further argued that applicant undertakes that he will abide by all the terms and conditions which may be imposed by this court and applicant undertakes that he will appear before the court on each and every date of hearing. Thus, he prayed that the present application be allowed.

2. On the other hand, learned APP for the State argued that offence against the accused is serious one and no ground is made out to grant him bail. Thus, it is prayed that the present application be dismissed.

3. After hearing the contentions of learned Counsel for the applicant/ accused and learned APP for the state and perused the record. A perusal of the record reveals that the accused/applicant has been booked for the offences under section 316(2),318(4),61(2) BNS. This court is of the view that the offence for which the accused is challaned is serious one and

no ground is made out to grant bail to the accused. Thus, the present bail application of the accused/ applicant namely Ashok Kumar under Sections 316(2), 318(4), 61(2) BNS stands dismissed.
