Heard the plaintiff on I.A. No. I and II filed for ex-parte temporary injunction against the defendants seeking not to alienate and not to change the nature of the plaint schedule property.

The suit is filed for the relief of declaration of ownership and declaration to declare the subsequent sale deeds executed by defendants among themselves in respect of site No.23, assessment No.67, khatha No.23/67 of Sana Enclave situated at Sathanuru Village.

Perused the documents and affidavit of the plaintiff filed to I.A. No. I and II. The plaintiff also produced certified copies of five documents today.

The plaintiff has produced sale deed executed by the defendant No.1 in his favour on 02-07-2016 and the also

produced subsequent sale deed executed by the defendants No.1 to 3 in favour of defendant No.4 on 09-11-2017. The photographs produced by the plaintiff show that, certain construction work have been taken up in the property. Therefore, the plaintiff has made out a case to issue ex-parte temporary injunction order as asked in I.A. No. I and II.

The defendants No.1 to 5 are restrained from alienation of plaint schedule property and they are further restrained from changing the nature of the plaint schedule property by way of ex-parte temporary injunction order till next date of hearing.

Plaintiff shall comply the provisions of Order 39 Rule 3 of C.P.C.
