The plaintiff has filed the IA no.2 under Order VI Rule 17 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure seeking permission to amend the plaint.

It is averred that certain typographical errors have inadvertently crept into the plaint. The plaintiff seeks to correct the said errors by substituting the incorrect word "April" wherever it occurs and by correcting the plaintiff's share from "1/3rd" to "1/7th".

Heard. Perused the application and the records.

The proposed amendments are only formal in nature and are sought to rectify typographical errors. The suit is still at its nascent stage and even summons have not yet been issued to the defendants. Therefore, no prejudice will be caused to the defendants if the proposed amendment is allowed.

*Accordingly, the application filed under Order VI Rule 17 of the Code of Civil Procedure is **allowed**.*

The plaintiff is permitted to carry out the proposed amendment to the plaint and furnish the A/plaint by 21.07.2026.
