- 3) Whether the defendant No.12 proves that, as per the counter claim, the defendants No.7, 8, 12 & 14 are entitled for equal shares in the suit schedule properties?
- 4) Whether the defendant No.16 proves that, he is entitled for 1/6th share out of 1/5th share of Late. Munianjinappa as per his counter claim?
- 5) Whether the defendants No.28 to 32 prove that, on 11.11.1968 a registered partition was effected among Thippaiah & plaintiff and after obtaining his share, the plaintiff has sold his share in favor of Anjinappa, Jayaramappa & others and therefore, the suit is not maintainable?
- 6) Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the relives claimed?
