Heard on the application of accused-applicant Balwinder Singh for regular bail under Section 61/1/14 Excise Act, PS Lehra.

The Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused argued that accused is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. The accused have already been behind the bars since 16.08.2022. As such, he has filed the present application seeking concession of regular bail.

Notice of the application was given to the State. However, no written reply has been filed by the State but the Ld. Counsel for the State argued that the accused involved in a serious allegations and contended that the accused do not deserve any regular bail.

I have heard the learned counsel for applicant/accused and learned APP for the State and perused the file. The applicant/accused was arrested on 16.08.2022. The presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take time and as such, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind bars. Therefore, the present bail application moved by the applicant/accused is hereby allowed, subject to furnishing of the bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 30,000/- with one surety in the like amount.

Bail bonds and surety bonds furnished, which are accepted and attested. Release warrants be issued immediately.
