**ISSUES**

- 1) Whether the plaintiff proves that, herself and the defendants No.1 to 7 are the members of the Hindu Joint Family and the suit schedule properties are their joint family properties in which she is having 1/7<sup>th</sup> share?
- 2) Whether the plaintiff further proves that, in spite of execution of Registered Sale Deed dated 24.06.2005 in favor of the defendants No.8 & 9, the suit is maintainable under the Amended Section 6 of Hindu Succession Act, 2005?
- 3) Whether the defendants No.1 & 5 prove that, the plaintiff and her mother Smt. Muniyamma along with defendants No.1 to 7 have alienated the joint family property bearing Sy.No.38 and 36/2 in favor of one Sri. Ravikumar under Registered Sale Deed dated 31.03.2008 and plaintiff has obtained sale consideration amount?
- 4) Whether the defendants No.1 & 5 further prove that, the joint family members have already effected partition before 25 years and obtained change of Khatha of properties to their respective names?
- 5) Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the relieves claimed?
