- 1) Whether the Plaintiffs prove that, they are the owners of suit schedule property?
- 2) Whether the plaintiffs prove that, they are in lawful possession of suit schedule property as on the date of presentation of suit?
- 3) Whether the plaintiffs prove that, the sale deed dated 17-09-2011 and agreement of sale deed dated 23-10-2013 are created deeds by the defendants and said sale deeds are not binding on them?
- 3) Whether the plaintiffs prove that, the defendants are trying to interfere with their possession over suit property?
- 4) Whether the plaintiff proves that, he is entitled for the relief of declaration, permanent injunction as claimed by them?
- 5) Whether the defendant No.4 proves that, the suit property has been granted to one Muniyappa S/o Kuvannanavr Munishamappa and defendant Nos.1 to 3 being the legal heirs of said Muniyappa S/o late Kuvannavar Munishamappa succeeded the suit property from him and sold the said property to him (defendant No.4) under registered sale deed dated 17-09-2011 and thus he came in possession of suit property as owner?
