The present petition is filed U/Sec. 54 of C.P.C. seeking to demarcate the property in terms of preliminary decree to effect division by meets and bounds.

The petitioners and respondents No.2 & 3 filed I.A. under Section 94(e) of C.P.C. seeking to restrain the respondent No.7 from disbursing the compensation. The petition schedule indicate lone property which is now acquired by respondent No.7. Therefore in order to save the interest of parties and to finally dispose off main petition, the compensation has to be protected. Hence I proceed to pass the following :

After depositing of said compensation, office is directed to seek further orders regarding deposit of said amount.
