

The present suit is pending before this I Addl. Senior Civil Judge Court. The plaintiff has shown the valuation of the subject matter is below ₹15,00,000/-, which is hit by Sec. 17 of Karnataka Civil Courts (Amendment) Act 2023.

In view of the Sec. 17 of Karnataka Civil Courts (Amendment) Act, 2023, and in view of the judgment dated 24.09.2025 in W.P. No.201536/2024, the common judgment dated 08.07.2026 in W.P. No.17588/2024 c/w W.A. No.200260/2025 and the Special Leave Petitions (Civil) Diary No.41602/2026 vide order dated 03.08.2026, wherein the constitutional validity of the aforesaid amendments has been upheld.

Consequently, the present suit, being within the pecuniary jurisdiction of the Civil Judge is required to be transferred to the concerned Court having jurisdiction.

Accordingly, the Office is hereby directed to transmit the entire records to the jurisdictional Civil Judge forthwith, in accordance with the aforesaid Amendment and the Administrative Directions issued by the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka.

Hence, the case stands transferred to the Jurisdictional Civil Court, Devanahalli.
