- 3) Whether the defendants No.6 & 9 prove that, the suit is bad for partial partition?
- 4) Whether the defendant No.6 proves that, after execution of Sale Deed in favour of defendants No.2, 7, 8, 10 & 12, the defendant No.1 and his siblings entered into Registered Partition Deed dated 15-11-2015 and without challenging the same, the suit is not maintainable?
- 5) Whether the defendant No.6 further proves that, the suit is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties?
- 6) Whether the suit is barred by limitation?
- 7) Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the relief of Partition and Separate Possession as sought for?
- 8) Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the relief of Declaration as sought for?
- 9) What Order or Decree?
