

ORDERS ON I.A. No.1

The Petitioners have filed the petition Under Sec.12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act 2005 seeking various Orders. The Petitioners seeking maintenance of Rs.50,000/- per month. The Petitioners also filed an interim application under Section 23(2) of PWDV Act seeking exparte ad-interim Order.

In the Application Petitioners pray to direct the Respondent to pay Rs.50,000/-per month as Interim Maintenance.

In the Affidavit it is stated that, the Respondent has subjected the Petitioners to physical and Mental torture. Now the Respondent has thrown out the Petitioners from the shared household. The Respondent having sufficient Income. The Petitioners are in poor condition and unable to maintain themselves. Hence, filed the above petition along with the interim application.

In support of their contention, the Petitioners have placed copy of marriage invitation, copy of Aadhar Cards, marks card, copy of complaint, copy of FIR and charge sheet. Perused the above said documents, it prima facie shows that the Petitioner No.1 is the legally wedded wife of Respondent and without any proper reasons the Respondent deserted the Petitioners from their marital home and the Petitioners is not in position to maintain themselves. For the above reason in my view an exparte interim Order may be granted to the Petitioners and it is appropriate to pass interim order directing the Respondent to pay interim maintenance for basic necessities like food, cloth, shelter and medical aid expenses as per the purport of the

provision and for protection of Petitioners. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:-

ORDER

The Respondent is directed to pay Rs.4,000/- per month to each Petitioners towards their interim maintenance till disposal of IA No.1.

Call for The Domestic Incident Report from the concerned CDPO.

Issue Notice On IA No.1 and Notice on Petition to the Respondent through CDPO R/by 04.05.2026.
