3. On examination of said patient I found 1 wound on the scalp in the occipital region and requiring 7 sutures. In my opinion the above injuries is grievous in nature and which was caused by a blunt object. In this regard I was issued wound certificate on dated 27.11.2012. The same certificate is identified by the witness and it is marked as Ex.P-3, signature of the witness is marked as Ex.P-3(a). The injury mentioned in the wound certificate may be sustained if the person assaulted with bear bottle.
