ORDER ON I.A NO.1

Plaintiff has filed I.A.No.I under Order XXXIX Rule 1 and 2 R/w Section 151 of CPC with a prayer to grant ex-parte ad-interim temporary injunction restraining the defendants, or their agents, workers, laboureres, henchmens, servants or anybody claiming through them from interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the A schedule property, till disposal of the suit.

In support of their application plaintiff filed his affidavit and produced the documents.

Heard learned counsel for the plaintiff. Perused the materials placed before me.

Plaintiff made out the prima-facie case. If ex-parte injunction is not granted the very purpose of filling of the suit will be defeated. Hence, this court is of the opinion that, by dispensing the issuance of prior notice, if injunction is granted till next date of hearing, it will meet the ends of justice. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:-

ORDER

The defendants, their agents or anybody claiming through him are hereby restrained by an order of ex-parte temporary injunction from

interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the A schedule property, till next date of hearing.

Issue exparte temporary injunction on I.A No.1 along with suit summons to the defendant after compliance under order 39(3) of CPC.

Issue suit summons to defendants by 18-12-2020.
