ORDER ON MAIN PETITION

The petitioners have filed this petition seeking issue directions to the respondent to enter the date of death of husband of petitioner No. 1, grand father of petitioners No. 2 and 3 by name Munidoddappa @ Doddaiiah S/o Late Munishamappa who died on **10-05-2007** at Maralakunte Village, Jala Hobli, Yelahanka Taluk.

The petition notice to the respondent was duly served. In spite of service of notice, the respondent did not appear before the court and did not file any objections to the main petition. The petitioner No. 2 has been examined as PW-1 and he has got marked the non-availability certificate at Ex.P.1, Genealogy tree at Ex.P.2, Notarized copies of adhaar cards of petitioners as Ex.P3 to Ex.P5. RTC as Ex.P6. The petitioner No. 2 has reiterated the contents of the petition in his examination in chief. There is nothing available on record to disbelieve the version stated by the petitioners on oath. Apart from this, the explanation given by the petitioners for non-informing the date of **death** to the concerned authorities is also satisfactory one. The petitioner No. 2 is the competent person to say regarding the **death** of his grandfather by name Munidoddappa @ Doddaiiah S/o Late Munishamappa. Hence, in my opinion the petitioners have made out grounds to issue directions to the respondents authority as prayed in the petition. Hence, I pass the following.

ORDER

The petition filed by the petitioners is hereby allowed.

The concerned respondent is hereby directed to register the date of death of

Munidoddappa @ Doddaiiah S/o Late
Munishamappa who died on **10-05-2007**
at Maralakunte Village, Jala Hobli,
Yelahanka Taluk and to issue death
certificate to the petitioners accordingly
by collecting late fees.
