Matter taken up today after it was en-blocked adjourned on 03.05.2021.

Present: Sh. Jatin Anand Ld. counsel for the complainant.
Sh. Amit Kumar Yadav Ld. counsel for the accused alongwith accused in person.
(Court Proceeding through Video Conferencing using Cisco Webex software).

1. Fresh vakalatnama filed on behalf of accused. Same is taken on record.
2. Accused has furnished the bail bonds in the sum of Rs 25,000/-. Sh. Raj Kumar has stood surety for the accused. The bail bonds are duly checked and accepted. A copy of RC of vehicle bearing number DL 3SES 4827 is taken on record. **RTO/MLO concerned be intimated**. Ld. Counsel for the accused is directed to deposit the original bail bonds with the Reader-cum-Ahlmad of this court before the NDOH. Surety is also required to be physically present at the time of depositing the original documents.
3. On little interaction with the parties it appears that there are chances of amicable settlement between the parties in this matter. Both the parties have been explained the procedure and advantage of mediation process.
4. Let the matter be put up with consent of both parties before Mediation Cell on **11.08.2021 at 10:00 AM** and returnable to this Court on **18.10.2021** after process of mediation.
5. Parties are directed to appear before Mediation Cell and before the Court on dates fixed. It is clarified that if the parties fail to appear before the mediation cell on the date and time fixed cost will be imposed on the next date of hearing. It is further clarified that in compliance of the law laid down in **Dayawati v. Yogesh Kumar Gosain, 2017 SCC OnLine Del 11032**, both parties be present in the Court on the next date of hearing for recording of statement if mediation succeeds.
6. In case mediation fails, the parties be present before the Court on the next date of hearing for framing of notice.
7. Reader/Ahlmad is directed to E-mail the e-file complete in all respects to Mediation Center well in time.
