As objection petition has been filed only on 15.06.2016, so there is no question of any exparte proceedings have been conducted on 03.05.2016 regarding which issue for setting aside has been framed. As such, the issue No.1 is redundant and only issue No.2 with regard to territorial jurisdiction remains and for that oral evidence is not required as it is now settled by Hon'ble Supreme Court that objection petitions under Section 34 of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 are to be decided on the basis of record of the Arbitrator and no evidence is required. Even if in case evidence is required then also only affidavit is sufficient. So, in such circumstances no oral evidence is required in this case. Now case is adjourned to 11.01.2019 for arguments.
