01.05.2025	Case called out. Accused persons namely (1) Diwakar Kumar and (2) Prabhakar Kumar are present. The record is at the stage of order on discharge petition filed on 17.04.2025 by the defence and the copy has been supplied to the complainant's advocate Sri Ashok Kumar Sinha. Heard the Ld. Advocate Sri Ram Prakash Kumar Ambashta on behalf of accused person. A discharge petition has been filed on behalf of accused persons, copy of such petition is supplied to complainant's advocate. It is further stated that there is no objection to the complainant's side and prayed that since there is no material to frame charges, so the accused petitioners deserve discharge in this case. No one turned up for complainant. Perused the record. On perusal this Court finds that prima facie case was made out under section 498A of IPC and section 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act against both the accused persons. From 12.12.2023, this record ran for before charge evidence, but during this period, the complainant remained absent and she did not produced any witnesses. The before charge evidence closed on 02.01.2025. The accused pressed the discharge petition on 30.04.2025, in such petition, the counsel of complainant has endorsed '<i>no objection</i>'. The Ld. Counsel of complainant appeared before the court on the court's direction and submitted his no objection on the discharge petition. Here, the complainant failed to produce any before charge evidence. The Ld. Advocate of complainant has also shown no objection to the discharge petition and it appears from the order sheet that complaint has no interest in this case since no pairvy has been
