It has been submitted by the JD that the claims of the decree-holder is false and frivolous as JD had already deposited Rs.15,000/- out of the decretal amount. Now, he is a person below poverty line and hence, as per judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court J.G.Varghes and another Versus Bank of Cochin, the JD should not be sent to civil imprisonment, same is opposed by counsel for DH. Since, these issues have already been discussed in the decree dated 07.12.2018 and there is no stay granted by any Ld.
