3. Whether the plaintiffs prove, the alleged interference to their possession over suit property by the defendants?
4. Whether plaintiffs prove that the sale deed of suit property executed by some of defendants in favour of other defendants dated 08-04-1968, 25-02-1996, 20-12-2004 and 23-02-2006 are illegal, null and void and not binding on them?
5. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for reliefs as prayed for?
6. Whether defendant No.3 proves that already partition took place in their joint family under registered partition deed dated 23-03-1970?
7. Whether defendant No.3 proves that the defendants No.1 to 5 have already sold out suit property in favour of defendant No.11 under registered sale deed dated 20-12-2004?
8. Whether defendant No.11 proves that he is bonafide purchaser of suit schedule property for valuable consideration under registered sale deed dated 20-12-2004 from defendants No.1 to 5?

9. Whether defendant No.11 proves that suit is barred by law of limitation?
