Accused person Jiyarul Hoque is present.

Seen the petition bearing no. 182/25, whereby the accused pleaded his guilt.

Heard both the sides.

Perused the Case Record and the petition.

The case is fixed at the stage of P.W. However, no witness is examined by prosecution till date.

The plea of guilt is found to be voluntary and hence accepted. Accordingly, the accused person is convicted u/s 279/338 IPC.

Considering the nature of offence u/s 279/338 IPC the Court does not deem it fit to extend the benefits of probation to the convict.

Heard the accused person on the point of sentence. Accused submitted that he is a poor man and sole earning member of his family and prayed for leniency in sentence.

No previous conviction is found against the accused person.

Considering the nature of the crime the accused is sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 1,000/- under section 279 of the IPC and in default to undergo

simple imprisonment for 5 days; fine of Rs. 1000/- u/s ³³⁸388 IPC and in default to undergo simple imprisonment for 5 days. The sentences shall run concurrently.

The case is disposed of.
