3. Whether the plaintiffs prove the alleged interference to their possession over the suit property by the defendant as on date of suit?
4. Whether plaintiffs are entitled for reliefs as prayed for?
5. Whether defendant proves that he has acquired title over suit property by virtue of registered Will deed dated 01-06-1954 executed by Late Sri.Veeranna @ Veerappa and acquired possession over the same?
6. Whether defendant proves that suit is barred by law of limitation?
7. Whether defendant proves that plaintiff No.1 and father of plaintiffs No.2 and 3 by name Sri.Giddappa had sold out their share in the joint family property in favour of one Sri.Nanjappa under registered sale deed dated 25-08-1954 as contended in Para No.23 of written statement?
8. Whether defendant proves that Court fee paid by the plaintiffs is not proper and correct?
9. What decree or order?
