1. Whether the plaintiff proves that the plaintiff is the absolute owner of the suit property?
2. Whether the plaintiff proves that the plaintiff is in actual and physical possession of the suit property as on the date of filing of the suit?
3. Whether the plaintiff proves that the defendants are making alleged interference over the plaintiff's possession over the suit property?
4. Whether the defendants No.1 to 3 prove that one Sri.Madappa, while he was in sound disposing state of mind, had executed a registered Will dated 03-02-1984 bequeathing the suit properties in favour of the defendant No.1?
5. Whether the defendants No.1 to 3 prove that said Sri.Madappa had cancelled the said registered Will dated 03-02-1984 by executed a registered deed of cancellation of Will dated 15-09-1997 for the reasons mentioned at para 14 of their written statement?
6. Whether the defendants No.1 to 3 prove that said Sri.Madappa, while he was in sound disposing state of

mind, had executed another Will bequeathing items No.1, 3 and 4 in favour of the defendants No.2 and 3?

7. Whether the defendants No.1 to 3 prove that item No.2 of the suit properties was the self acquired property of said Sri.Madappa?
8. Whether the defendants No.1 to 3 prove that said Sri.Madappa and the defendant No.1 had sold item No.4 of the suit properties in favour of defendants No.4 to 7?
9. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the relief claimed?
10. What decree or order?
