

Perused plaint averments particularly paragraph No.3 to 9 of the plaint and suit documents i.e., G.Tree, certified copy of sale deed dated b14-05-1952, RTCs of suit property, mutation register extract of suit property and Paragraph No.3 and 4 of the affidavit accompanying I.A.No.I filed Advocate for plaintiffs Sri.B.Manjunath.

On perusal of pleadings i.e., paragraph No.3 to 9 of the plaint and suit documents i.e., G.Tree, certified copy of sale deed dated b14-05-1952, RTCs of suit property, mutation register extract of suit property and Paragraph No.3 and 4 of the affidavit accompanying I.A.No.I and on perusal of suit documents. So also on hearing the arguments of learned Advocate for plaintiffs. I am of the opinion that plaintiffs have made out prima-facie case for grant of exparte ad-interim injunction orders against the defendants as prayed in I.A.No.I atleast till next date of hearing. Hence, I proceed to following order:

ORDER

The defendants are hereby restrained from alienating suit schedule property either by creating any kind of charge like sale, mortgage and third party interest over the suit properties till next date of hearing.

Plaintiff to comply order 39 Rule 3(A) of C.P.C.

Office not to issue certified copies of this order untill orders are complied.

Office to issue temporary injunction warrant shall contain the details of suit schedule properties shown in schedule of the suit schedule properties after prayer column on page No.4 and 5 of the plaint.

Issue suit summons and notice of I.A.No.I to defendants.
