I S S U E S

1. Whether the plaintiffs prove that they along with defendant No.1 to 11 are the members of Hindu undivided joint family and suit schedule properties are their ancestral and joint family properties?
2. Whether plaintiffs further prove that the compromise decree passed in O.S.No.51/2002 on 15.03.2003 is not binding on their shares with respect to suit schedule properties ?
3. Whether plaintiffs further prove that the judgment and decree passed in O.S.No.256/2002 on 27.04.2015 and the judgment and decree passed in R.A.No.10122/2016 on 13.01.2017 are not binding on their shares with respect to suit schedule properties ?
4. Whether defendant No.5 proves that plaintiffs grand mother Smt.Rudramma D/o.Munisiddaiah W/o.Late Rudraiah had already taken her share in Sy.No.94 measuring 2 acre 20 guntas from Late Munisiddaiah

and sold the same in favour of late Timmaiah for the legal necessities of herself and her legal heirs under a Registered sale deed dated:26.05.1967 ?

5. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the relief of partition and separate possession through metes and bounds as sought for ?
6. Whether plaintiffs are entitle for declaratory reliefs as sought for?
7. What order or decree?
