

ORDER

The complainant Amir Hussain is present along with his Ld. Counsel.

The complainant has filed the instant complaint petition submitting inter-alia that the accused persons have abducted the mother of the informant in demand of Rs.2,00,000/-. As such the complainant has made the instant petition for directing the O/C Rowta P.S. to investigate the case.

Perused and heard.

It is pertinent to mention herein that the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Sakiri Vasu V State of UP AIR 2008 SC 907** has held that the Section 156 (3), Cr.P.C. is wide enough to include all such powers in a Magistrate which are necessary for ensuring a proper investigation, and it includes the power to order registration of an FIR and of ordering a proper investigation, if the Magistrate is satisfied that a proper investigation has not been done, or is not being done by the police.

Considering the law laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court and also considering the materials-on-record, I deem it

proper to allow the prayer of the petitioner. Accordingly, O/C Rowta P.S. is directed to register the FIR of the instant petitioners in respect of the case at hand.

Send the instant complaint petition along with this order to the O/C, Rowta P.S. for necessary compliance.

Make a supplementary case record.

B/A is to do the needful.

Matter is disposed of accordingly.
