5. **Point No.1:** It is well established rule that the substituted service cannot be issued in the cavalier manner and only should be opted as a last resort. Here the court has to see whether the summons in the ordinary course could not be served on defendants as they are intentionally avoiding the service of the summons.

6. After perusal of the material available on record it appears that the steps taken by the plaintiff to send the summons to the defendants is not leading any fruits. As the summons on the

defendants is not getting served. Accordingly this court proceed to answer **point No.1 in the Affirmative.**

Thereby issue notice to defendants by way of paper publication.
