Sri. Arun Kumar. K.H. (A.R.K) Advocate files Vakalth for accused along with application U/sec. 276(2) of B.N.S.S.

Counsel for the accused No.1 and 2 is ready to plead guilty for the offence punishable U/sec. 281, 125(a), 125(b) of B.N.S. R/w Sec. 196 of IMV Act.

Plea is recorded, the same is read over and explained to the counsel for accused No.1 and 2. The counsel for accused No.1 and 2 has admitted the plea. The plea of the accused No.1 and 2 is voluntary. The consequences of the plea of guilty is also explained to the counsel for accused No.1 and 2. Even after which the counsel for accused No.1 and 2 pleaded guilty of the alleged offence. Hence, plea is hereby accepted. Accordingly the following;

ORDER

Acting U/sec. 276 of B.N.S.S. the accused No.1 and 2 are hereby convicted for an offence punishable u/Sec. 281, 125(a), 125(b) of B.N.S. R/w Sec. 196 of IMV Act.

The accused No.1 is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.1,000/- for the offence punishable under Sec.281 of BNSS in default to undergo S.I. for 1 day.

The accused No.1 is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.2,500/- for the offence punishable under Sec.125(a) of

BNSS in default to undergo S.I. for 1 day.

The accused No.1 is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.3,000/- for the offence punishable under Sec.125(b) of BNSS in default to undergo S.I. for 1 day.

The accused No.2 is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.2,000/- for the offence punishable under Sec.196 of IMV Act in default to undergo S.I. for 1 day.

Office to take fine amount.

In this case accused No.1 and 2 have pleaded guilty.

Hence, case is disposed accordingly.
