Chief-examination by Learned A.P.P. :- .

I have served as Senior Motor Vehicle Inspector, RTO in K R Puram, Regional Office from 2010 to 2012.

On 2.09.2011 on request of D C, Bengaluru Rural we have conducted raid on sand filter center situated at Kalkunte Village wherein sand was illegally filtered. C.W.1 to 3 , 5 to 7 were also with us. When we reached the spot the persons who were involved in the alleged act had run away. There were 9 Diesel Motors we have seized the same. On 25.11.2011 police have recorded my statement with regard to the identification of accused.

Cross examination by Sri R R advocate for accused:

I have not produced order copy issued by DC. There were water in some areas in the pond. I cannot say what are the instruments required to filter the sand. The Diesel motors which were seized by us 9 in total, out of them one was in good condition. It is false to suggest that mahazar was conducted on the day on which complaint was lodged. I do not know whether other motors were working in condition or not. I do not know that to filter the sand pipes are required along with motor. It is false to suggest that we have lodged false complaint against the accused. It is false to suggest that now I am deposing false in order to help prosecution case.

Oath has been duly administered to the witness on this 22nd September 2022.

Chief-examination by Learned A.P.P. :- .

I have worked as District Watershed Development Officer, Bengaluru, from 2005 to 2012.

On 2.09.2011 on request of D C, Bengaluru Rural we have conducted raid on sand filter center situated at Kalkunte Agrahara Village wherein sand was illegally filtered. C.W.1 to 3 to 7 were also with us. When we reached the spot the persons in Sy.no.22 of Kalkunte Agrahara Village the persons were involved in the filtering sand by the time we went there the person who were involved in alleged act had run away. There were 9 Diesel Motors we have seized the same. I have given statement before police.

Cross examination by Sri R R advocate for accused:

I have not produced order copy issued by DC. We left Bengaluru on that day at 7 A.M. We went along with our Taluka Level Officers. It was 8 -8.15 A.M when we reached there. I have not mentioned the time in my statement. There was water in the pond. It is true to suggest that to filter the sand there should sufficient water. It is false to suggest that there was no water in the pond when we reached there. It is false to suggest that had it been there water in the pond we could not reach there. Accused had stored the sand in the spot and there were pouring it in the bowl. When it is suggested to the witness that have seized the bowl, witness voluntarily says the Taluk Officers have seized it. Police seized 9 diesel motors in the spot. I did not see whether the said motors were in working condition or not. The seized motors might have been out of order but when we went there the said motors were working. It is false to suggest that pipes are required to filter the sand. It is false to suggest that accused had not filter the sand we had lodged false complaint against them. It is false to suggest that I have not given before the police. I do not know whether seized motor are produced before the court or not. It is false to suggest that now I am deposing false in order to help prosecution case.
