

Case called out.

Summons issued to accused unserved.

Since, 29.08.2015 matter posted for issue summons to accused. Despite sufficient opportunity the complainant did not choose to serve the summons.

The labour inspector, Hoskote has filed the present complaint under section 200 of Cr.P.C for the offence punishable under section 23 of the Contract Labour(Regulation and Abolition Act). After taking cognizance of the offence, summons was ordered to be issue on accused. Despite issuance of several summons, the presence of the

accused is not secured. The present case is more than ten years old. The offence alleged against the accused is of summons case. At this juncture, I am of the opinion that the proceedings shall be stopped with a liberty to reopen the case after securing the accused. Accordingly, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

Acting under Section 258 of Cr.P.C., the further proceedings of this case is stopped with a liberty to reopen the case after securing the accused.
