This Detailed Accident Report (DAR) is treated as petition under section 166 (4) of the M.V. Act. Be registered accordingly.

Copy of DAR supplied to the injured / petitioner and respondents.

Since the vehicle is uninsured and it is stated to be lying seized, both the respondents are directed to deposit the security amount of Rs.1 lakh each in the form of FDRs in the name of the court on the next date.

Further, it is observed that photograph of the place of accident have not been placed on record. It is mentioned by IO that since the parties were initially talking about settlement, no formal complaint was given and the vehicle was not seized immediately after the accident. It is mentioned by the father of the deceased that he had taken the photographs of the spot immediately after the accident. IO is directed to collect the said photographs and place them on record by the next date.

Further, original medical bills / treatment papers of the deceased be also placed on record on the next date.
