Business : CP present and filed memo stating that suit may be dismissed against D8, 9 and 11. Heard and in view of memo filed by the plaintiff suit is dismissed against D9. Plaintiff for IA No.2 U/O 1 rule 10 of CPC implead PD No. 23 and 24 and also filed IA No.3 U/O 6 rule 17 of CPC. Sri PKP advocate vakalath for p/defs and submitted no objections to the above applications. Heard and by noting no objection IA No. 2 and 3 allowed. SRI RDN advocate filed vakalath for D1 and 18. D1 to 10 and 12 to 22 filed WS in two sets along with memo adopting the same as objection to IA NO.1. Further, D1 to 7, 10, 12 to 22 filed IA No.4 U/O 3 rule 2 of CPC with GPA seeking permission to prosecute the case on behalf of D1 through GPA Holder D7. Heard and by noting no objection by the plaintiff IA NO.4 allowed. The D7 is permitted to prosecute the case as GPA Holder of D1. Plaintiff is directed amend the plaint and furnish A/P. Amendment carried out. A/P furnish. D 23 and 24 filed memo adopting the WS of D1 to 7, 10, 12 to 22 on their behalf. The Plaintiff, Defendants, GPA Holder of D10 and their respective counsels present. Deliberation held. Both the parties agreed to compromise the matter. In view of the same they have filed compromise petition U/o 23 Rule 3 of CPC along with their I.D proof and copy of layout plan. Read over the compromise petition in the language known them. They admitted the contents of compromise petition as true and correct. Hence, compromise petition is allowed. In view of compromise between the parties suit is decreed. The terms of compromise petition shall be the part and parcel of the compromise decree. Draw final decree accordingly.
