**Business** : ORDERS ON I.A The petitioner has filed I.A U/Sec 151 of CPC with voucher along with affidavit to release the compensation amount deposited by the respondent. On perusal of records and as per orders passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka in MFA.No.6871/2012 the orders passed by the Labour Officer was confirmed by directing them to deposit the compensation amount before this court. In compliance to the same, the respondents have deposited the compensation amount along with interest. Furthermore, the said order of the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka was not modified or challenged by the respondents. Therefore, as per orders passed by the Labour Officer, office is hereby directed to kept a sum of Rs.1,25,000/- in a nationalized bank in fixed deposit for a period of 5 years and shall release the remaining amount of Rs.2,65,188/- along with entire interest in favour of the petitioner after due verification and identification of the parties.
