

ORDERS ON IA NO.1

This suit is filed by the plaintiffs against the defendants for partition and separate possession in respect of suit properties. In support of their case, they have produced copy of genealogical tree, RTC and mutation extracts along with copy of sale deeds and the statement of account. A perusal of above records it shows the suit properties are belongs to joint family. The plaintiffs are apprehended that the defendants are trying to alienate the suit properties. If the defendants are allowed to alienate the same, the very purpose of filing the suit will be defeated. Therefore, at this stage the plaintiffs have made out a prima facie case to grant an order of injunction restraining the defendants from alienating the suit properties as prayed in IA No.1.

Hence, in order to avoid multiplicity of proceedings and also to safe guard the interest of plaintiffs, it is just and necessary to pass ex-parte temporary injunction against the defendants as sought in the I.A No.1. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The defendants are hereby restrained from alienating or encumbering the suit schedule properties in any manner till next date of hearing as prayed in IA No.1.

The plaintiffs are hereby directed to comply as per the order 39 Rule 3A of CPC.

Issue suit summons and notice on ex-parte temporary injunction order on IA.No.1 to the defendants.
