

### **ORDERS ON IA NO.2 to 7**

The plaintiffs filed I.A.No.2 Under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 of CPC restrain the defendants from creating any encumbrance with respect to suit schedule property and they have produced copy of GPA, legal notice and RTC extracts in respect of the suit property.

The plaintiffs have filed I.A.No.3 to 7 Under Order 32 Rule 3 R/w Section 151 of CPC for appointment of plaintiff No.3 as natural guardian to the minor plaintiff No.6, plaintiff No.7 to minor plaintiff No.9 and 10, plaintiff No.11 to minor plaintiff No.13, plaintiff No.14 to minor plaintiff No.16 and 17 and plaintiff No.18 to minor plaintiffs No.20 and 21 to proceed with the case.

Perused the affidavits and the documents. The plaintiff No.6, 9, 10, 13, 16, 17, 20 and 21 are minors and represented through their natural guardian. As the suit is filed for consequential relief of declaration, the presence of minor plaintiffs through their guardians are necessary to determine the real dispute between the parties. Therefore, it is just and necessary to appoint plaintiff No.3, 7, 11, 14 and 18 respectively as natural guardian to plaintiffs No.6, 9, 10, 13, 16, 17, 20 and 21 to prosecute the case.

On perusal of available records the plaintiffs are having prima facie case at this stage. If the defendants are allowed to alienate or create any mode of documents in favour of third parties the very purpose of filing of this suit will be defeated and it may leads to multiplicity of proceedings. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

**ORDER**

The I.A. No.3 to 7 filed Under Order 32 Rule 3 R/w Section 151 of CPC is hereby allowed.

The plaintiff No.3, 7, 11, 14 and 18 respectively as natural guardian to minor plaintiffs No.6, 9, 10, 13, 16, 17, 20 and 21 to prosecute the case.

Further, the defendants are hereby restrained from alienating or encumbering the suit schedule property in any manner till next date of hearing as prayed in IA No 2.

The plaintiffs are hereby directed to comply as per order 39 rule 3A of CPC.

Issue suit summons to the defendants and notice on ex-parte temporary injunction order on IA No.2 to the defendants.
