No DW is present. Accused-persons have closed their
defence evidence.

Arguments heard. Vide my separate detailed judgment of
even date, the accused-persons have been acquitted of the offence charged
with, as stated therein. Accused-persons are directed to furnish personal
bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each with one surety in the like amount, in
view of the provisions of Section 437-A of Cr.P.C. Bonds furnished which
has been accepted and attested.

At this stage, accused-persons moved an application for
accepting and attesting the bail/surety bonds already furnished by them
for previously with the challan be kindly read in the bail bonds under
Section 437-A Cr.P.C on the grounds that they are poor persons and
working as rag pickers/car baize collectors. Heard. In view of the contents
mentioned in the application same is hereby allowed.

Earlier bail/surety bonds furnished by accused-persons are
considered as bonds under Section 437-A Cr.P.C. Reader of this court is
directed to give note on the previous bonds furnished by accused-persons
in this regard.

Case property, if any, be disposed of as per law after expiry
of period for filing appeal, revision or result thereof if any. After due
compliance, file be consigned to the Record Room.
