4. *The defendant no.1, 3 & 4 further proves that, after execution of gift deed dated 27-09-1982 the defendant no.1 and 2 and husband of plaintiff no.1 started being separate and cultivating their 1/3rd share in gifted properties?*
5. *The defendant no.1,3 & 4 further proves that , item no.3 is self acquired properties of defendant no.1 by virtue of registered sale deed dated 20-02-1982?*

6. *The defendant no.1, 3 and 4 further proves that item no.10 is self acquired properties of defendant no.1 by virtue of registered sale deed dated 23-12-1986?*
7. *Whether Plaintiffs are entitled for the relief as prayed for?*
8. *What order or decree?*
