an objection petition under Section 34 of the Arbitration and
Conciliation Act, 1996, seeking setting aside of the Arbitral
Award dated 06.04.2022 passed by the Deputy Commissioner,
Sirsa. However, the petition has been registered as Land
Acquisition matter. Ahlmad is directed to get the same registered
as an Arbitration matter and update the same in the CIS.

proceedings have been received and attached in ARB-258-2024.

impleaded as respondent no.5.
