In the present matter issue of limitation is involved. As Hon'ble Supreme Court is seized of the matter and Hon'ble Supreme Court its order dated 16.12.2025 in case titled as 'Bhagirathi Dash vs. Union of India & Anr.' has been pleased to state that the pendency of claim petition would not come in the way of matter being taken up by the Tribunal except at the final decision/passing of judgment.
