Accused No.1 to 7 are present.

The accused No.1 to 7 voluntarily submitted that they are willing to plead guilty of the offence alleged against them in this case.

The case papers were furnished to the accused No.1 to 7 as required under Section 230 of BNSS.

The Adalath has warned the accused No.1 to 7 that if they plead guilty, they may have to pay fine. In spite of the same, the accused No.1 to 7 proceeded to plead guilty. The gist of accusation for the offence punishable under section 87 of Karnataka Police Act is recorded in the form of plea and the same is read over and explained to them in the language known to them. They pleaded guilty and their plea of guilt is found voluntary and free from coercion and undue influence of any kind. Hence, the Adalath proceeds to pass following.,

ORDER

Acting under section 275 of BNSS accused No.1 to 7 are convicted for the offence punishable under section 87 of Karnataka Police Act.

Since the accused No.1 to 7 have pleaded guilty before Lok Adalath and as this is a first time offence, lenient view is taken and accused No.1 to 7 are sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.300/-

each. In default to pay fine, they shall undergo S.I for 2 days each.

Properties seized in PF No. 166/2026, dated 08.05.2026, item No.1 of Rs.5000/- is ordered to be confiscated in favour of state.

The item No.2 of 52 is playing cards is being worthless and item No.3 is one plastic bag. Hence, ordered to be destroyed.

The accused persons permitted to pay fine on or before 11.07.2026
