ORDER:

Accused Jarnail Singh was sent up to face trial under Section
21(1) and 21(4) of the Mines and Minerals (Development and
Regulations) Act, 1957, by the SHO of Police Station Tanda.

CASE OF THE PROSECUTION:

2. The case of the prosecution is that the present case was
registered on the basis of the application moved by Sh. Jatin Garg, JE-

cum-Mining Inspector, Dasuya, against Jarnail Singh son of Manjit Singh. It is alleged in the application that on 25-08-2024, one tractor trolley, which was driven by Jarnail Singh son of Manjit Singh and which had a trolley loaded with sand, was apprehended in the area of Village Abdullahpur *choe* and the driver of the said tractor trolley could not produce any legal document for carrying out the mining. Accordingly, raid was conducted by the police party headed by ASI Amarjit Singh. The tractor trolley make Mahindra-575 DI, without number, was taken into possession at the spot and the site plan was prepared. Accused Jarnail Singh was arrested. After completion of investigation and other attendant formalities, a report was prepared in terms of Section 193 BNSS and was presented in the Court.

3. On presentation of the report under Section 193 BNSS in the Court, copies of the documents relied upon by the prosecution were supplied to the accused free of cost, as provided under Section 230 BNSS.

4. On perusal of the report furnished by the police under Section 193 BNSS, a prima facie case for the alleged commission of offence punishable under Section 21(1) and 21(4) of the Mines and Minerals Act is made out against accused Jarnail Singh. The offence under Section 21(1) and 21(4) of the Mines and Minerals act is exclusively triable by the Court of Sessions. As such, the present case is hereby committed to the learned Court of Sessions, Hoshiarpur. Accused Jarnail Singh is directed to appear before the learned Court of Sessions,
